Three Year Old Preschool

The environment is set up to challenge our preschoolers as they work on pre-reading and math concepts which will provide them with the tools to prepare them for their next school experience.



Kindergarten Prep



The environment is set up to challenge our Kindergarten Prep children as they work on leveled reading and math concepts based on formal and informal assessments throughout the course of the school year.




Science Spin
