#### **EOY Reminders**

#### <u>New Law in Effect</u>

Please make sure that, if you are not chaperoning a field trip, your student comes in that day with a booster seat.



#### This Week with Mrs. Kelly

It was great to have the students back! Students are completing the final lessons of the Second Step curriculum for the school year. K Prep worked on strategies to help wait and learned that counting quietly can help. Kindergarten focused on how to handle disagreements with other students and revisited the "Fair Ways to Play." Grades 1 & 2 are learning and practicing Second Step's problem-solving STEP framework: **S** (Say the problem), **T** (Think of solutions), **E** (Explore consequences/outcomes) and **P** (Pick the best solution). Grade 3 worked on inclusion and reviewed how to be a good friend. Grade 4 reviewed STEP, focusing on what makes a good problem solver. Grade 5 wrapped up the unit on empathy & kindness by presenting their community solutions. Grade 6 practiced self-reflection and planned their final visit to Villa Marie.
