EOY Reminders

DOVES hours are due by **Friday, May 30th**. Incomplete hours will be added to FACTS at a rate of \$30 per hour with a maximum of \$450.

No School for Kindergarten ONLY May 5th.

Next Spirit Day is Monday, May 12th **NOT Monday, May 5th.**

Keep your kids safe! Do not park in the drop-off line in the mornings. If you need to park, go to the parking lot. Students should be exiting out of the right side of the car, not the left.

New Law in Effect

All students must be in at least a booster seat unless they are eight years old or over 4'9". This means for **any** field trip for first grade and under (and many of the second graders) must be in a booster seat for field trips. Please make sure that, if you are not chaperoning a field trip, your student comes in that day with a booster seat.



This Week with Mrs. Kelly

It was great to have the students back! Students are completing the final lessons of the Second Step curriculum for the school year. K Prep worked on strategies to help wait and learned that counting quietly can help. Kindergarten focused on how to handle disagreements with other students and revisited the "Fair Ways to Play."

Grades 1 & 2 are learning and practicing Second Step's problem-solving STEP framework: **S** (Say the problem), **T** (Think of solutions), **E** (Explore consequences/outcomes) and **P** (Pick the best solution). Grade 3 worked on inclusion and reviewed how to be a good friend. Grade 4 reviewed STEP, focusing on what makes a good problem solver. Grade 5 wrapped up the unit on empathy & kindness by presenting their community solutions. Grade 6 practiced self-reflection and planned their final visit to Villa Marie.

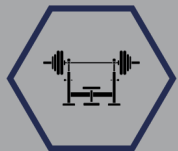
