Our 8<sup>th</sup> graders have a full-page article in the church bulletin **this weekend**.

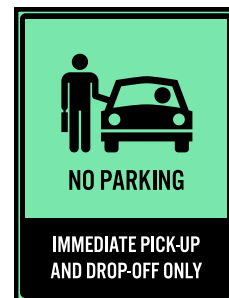
We have parishioners who work very hard on making our school and parish grounds look amazing. **Please keep your children out of the plants at the front of the school.**

## Lunch updates

We have heard your feedback! Healthier sides have been offered in the past, but the students are opting to either not take them or choose the less healthy option. However, Mrs. Scaramucci is working with Mr. Modes to improve the sides and provide more options. We are also looking into the possibility of a milk program for next year as well as lunch credits in lieu of makeups for snow days.

Our lunch program proceeds benefit the school every day! Monday, Tuesday, and Friday goes towards the school. Wednesday goes towards the 8<sup>th</sup> grade trip. Thursday goes to SEPA.

**New law in effect:** All students must be in at least a booster seat unless they are eight years old or over 4'9". This means for **any** field trip for first grade and under (and many of the second graders) must be in a booster seat for field trips. Please make sure that, if you are not chaperoning a field trip, your student comes in that day with a booster seat.

# STAR Scores from Spring 2025

Individual STAR reports will be sent out with fourth quarter report cards.

**Scaled Score:** Ranges from 0-1400 and spans grades 1-12. It is calculated based on the difficulty of the questions and the number of correct responses. Scaled Score is useful for comparing student performance over time and across grades.

**Grade Equivalent:** Represents how a student's test performance compares with that of other students nationally. For example, if the GE is 5.2, that means this student scores the same as an average fifth grade in the second month, NOT that they can complete fifth-grade level material.

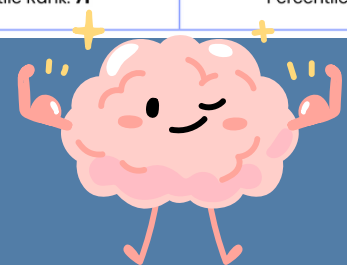
**Percentile Rank:** Scores range from 1-99 and express student ability relative to the scores of other students in the same grade nationally. For example, if the percentile rank is 75, the student's skills are greater than 75% of other children in the same grade that scored similarly nationwide.

**Instructional Reading Level:** A criterion-referenced score that is the highest reading level at which a student is 80% proficient or higher at comprehending material with assistance.

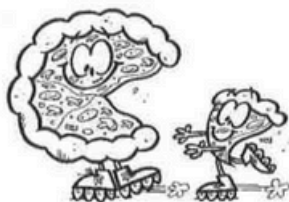
