Jim took lightly. The surrounding Catholic schools have had a security person or are currently in the process of hiring one. SEC Shield came highly recommended. November 3 is the potential start date for our security person. Donations are coming in- at almost \$5,000. Livonia Officer from Homeland Security came through the building and did a site assessment. St. Edith is ahead of the curve when it comes to security. The Christian Service Door is the big hot topic and "soft spot".
