### **Uniform Reminders**

Shorts are good to go for the remainer of the school year!

Everyone is growing, and with that comes shorter skirts.

Remember that skirts should not be rolled and no more than a couple of inches above the knee. If you are in need of a longer skirt, we have a few available for consignment.

Leggings under skirts should be solid black or solid blue, not gray. The leg should be tapered (no flare).

Grades 3-8 should be wearing a belt with pants.

K-4 girls must wear jumpers next year. The exception is for add-to-uniform Fridays where K-4 girls can wear skirts with a St. Edith shirt.
