- This group is not meant to function as a formal source of school information. Please continue to utilize your child’s teacher and the office for important school matters.
- This group is for positive communication/inquiries. Please refrain from sharing negative experiences regarding school matters. Contact teachers/administrators/group leaders directly to address your issues. Please refrain from complaining or gossiping. Violating these expectations will result in being removed from the group.
