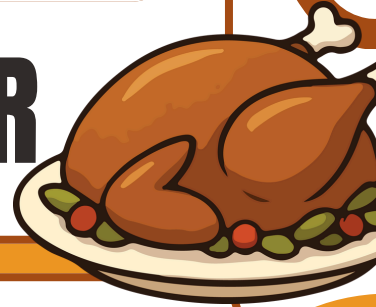

December Lunch is open and will close on **Friday, November 21st!**

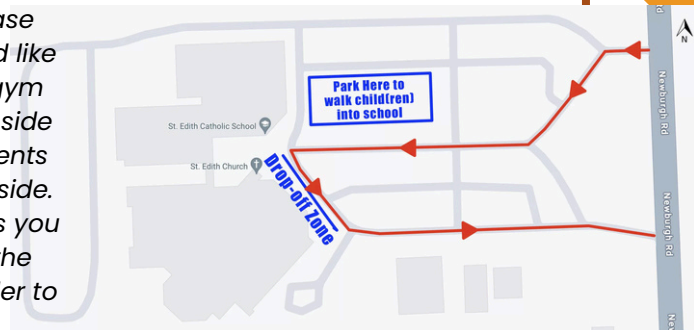
**Join the SEPA Facebook group** to get up-to-date information specific to St. Edith parents. Like GroupMe, it is another way to make sure you know everything going on at school!

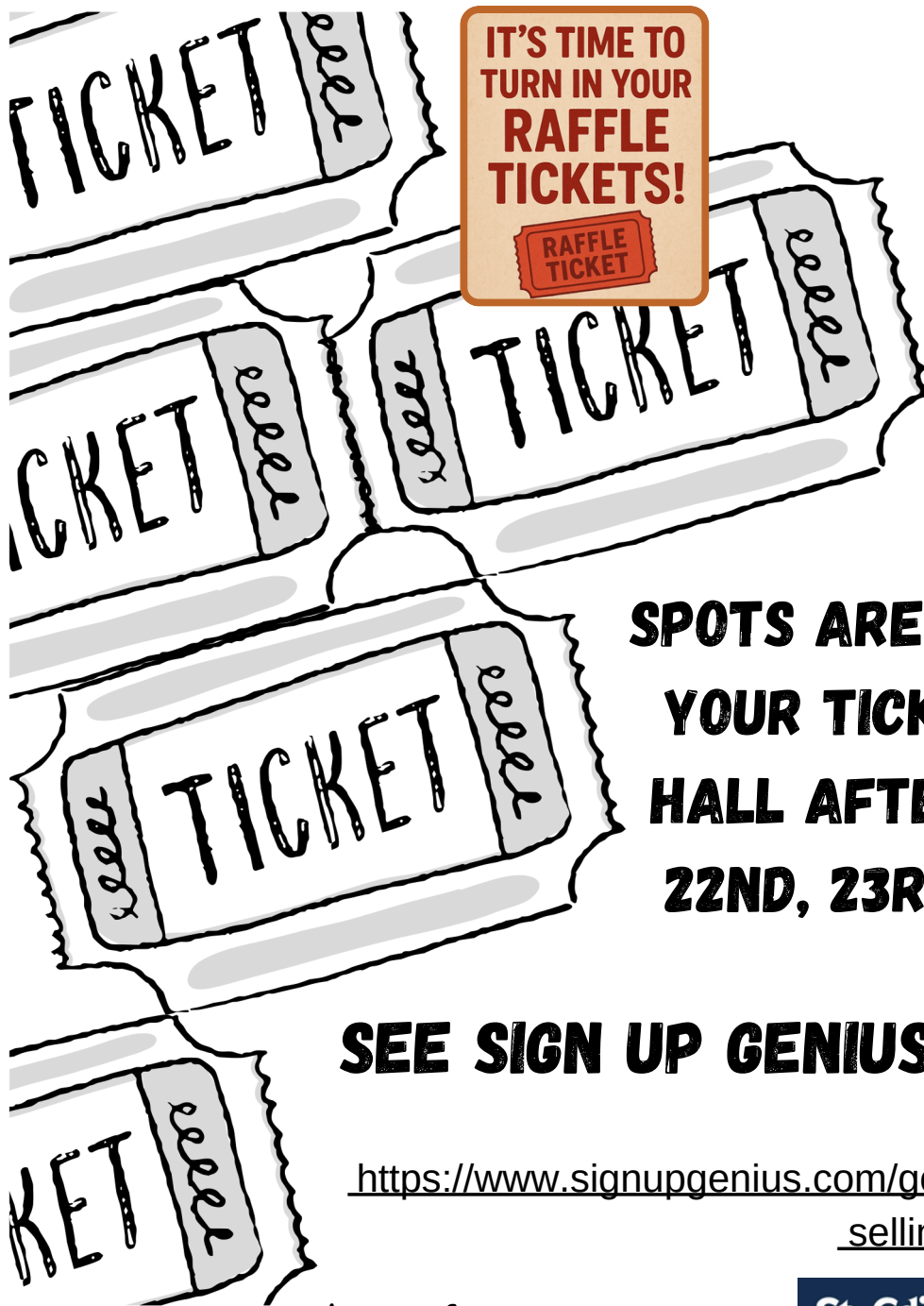

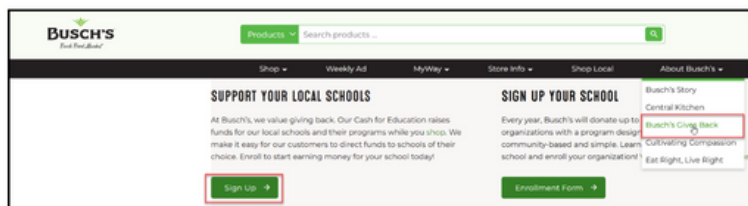

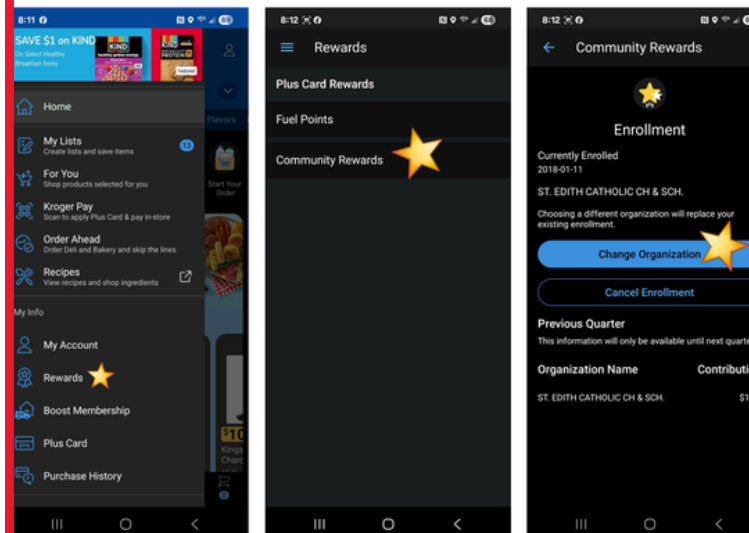
