- Tuition Assistance for the 2026-27 school year opened on Monday, December 15th. It is due at the end of February.
- if you have not already, please fill out your re-enrollment for next year! You do not need to attach the files for baptism, first communion, etc. Those forms are only required for new students.
- You do not need to make a new account on FACTS. In fact, please do not a new account. Log in. On the left side, click on "Apply/Enroll", and then "Enrollment/Re-enrollment".
- If you have siblings who have not yet registered, please start a new application at this time as well.
- There is an \$11 enrollment fee from FACTS per kid. Last year, it was rolled into tuition. However, this year, FACTS is doing this on the front end.

The enrollment fee will not be charged to FACTS until tuition is made available for the 2026-27 school year. Tuition rates will be available in January.


