## This Week with Mrs. Kelly

We're reaching for the gold this week in SEL! Lucy and Charles visited K Prep to teach about accidents and the best way to handle them. We practiced saying, "I'm sorry. It was an accident. Is there anything I can do to help?" In Kindergarten, we explored how feelings show up in our bodies. Puppy and Snail were back in 1st grade to share how people can have different feelings and how feelings can change. 2nd grade practiced predicting feelings to better manage outcomes. 3rd grade focused on care for creation by learning all about reducing, reusing and recycling. 4th grade worked in pairs to practice learning others points of view which is a building block to empathy. Grade 5 continued to expand their coping skill toolbox.

**Friday, February 27th:** Grades: PS4, 5th, and 8th


**Friday, March 6th:** Grades: K-Prep, 6th, and 7th

**Friday, March 13th:** Grades: Kindergarten, 4th, and 3rd


**Friday, March 20th:** Grades: 1st, 2nd, 4th, K-Prep, and 8th




