## Updates and Reminders

*"Are we going outside today?"* I go off of Accuweather Real Feel for Livonia (not Feels Like, Windchill, etc.). If the Real Feel is 10 degrees or above, we will be going outside.

Make sure you are following the handbook for socks. Solid-colored socks only! Light blue is not a uniform color anymore. Pink is not acceptable on socks or shoes.

Hair check! Please make sure boys' hair is above eyebrows, ears, and collar. Also, make sure hair is brushed. The overall appearance of all students should be neat, clean, and well-groomed. If you are wearing pants or shorts on non-PE days in grades 3-8, you must have a belt!



*March 24<sup>th</sup> is the start of the fourth quarter and the return of shorts!*

Remember that your child needs to be 24 hours/one day vomit, diarrhea, and fever-free without the aid of medication in order to return to school. Washing hands, not just hand sanitizer, is the best way to slow/stop the spread.

## This Week with Mrs. Kelly

We're ready for Spring in SEL! Kinders have been knocking it out of the park with the collection for Seedlings! We learned more about Braille and they learned how to spell their names in Braille. K Prep, Grade 1 & Grade 2 explored how we identify our own feelings and how they can show up in our bodies physically in sensations like a fast heartbeat, "butterflies" in the tummy and balled up fists. Grade 3 learned what helps a small group work together better. Grade 4 revisited the importance of learning the whole story and not jumping to conclusions. The best way to do that? Ask questions and listen to the answers. 5th grade learned how to identify what about a situation they could change to make it less stressful.
