## This Week with Mrs. Kelly

We worked hard in SEL this week! The classes downstairs practiced Second Step's 3 steps to calming down when you're having big feelings like frustration and embarrassment. The 3 steps are: 1) Stop, 2) Name your feeling & 3) Calm down (pick a strategy like belly breathing, counting, etc.). This helps the thinking part of the brain catch up with the emotional part and can lead to better outcomes. 4th grade did a deep dive on empathy and read "The Invisible Boy." We had a good discussion about what it's like to feel invisible and how to help other students "feel visible." 5th grade wrapped up their unit on managing emotions by creating a plan for making a situation that causes them to feel stressed, sad or other big emotions better.



**Friday, March 6th:** Grades: K-Prep, 6th, and 7th


**Friday, March 13th:** Grades: Kindergarten, 4th, and 3rd
