Updates and Reminders

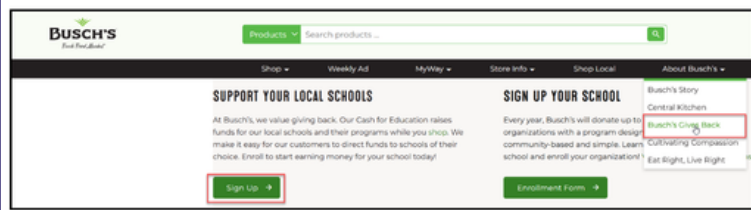

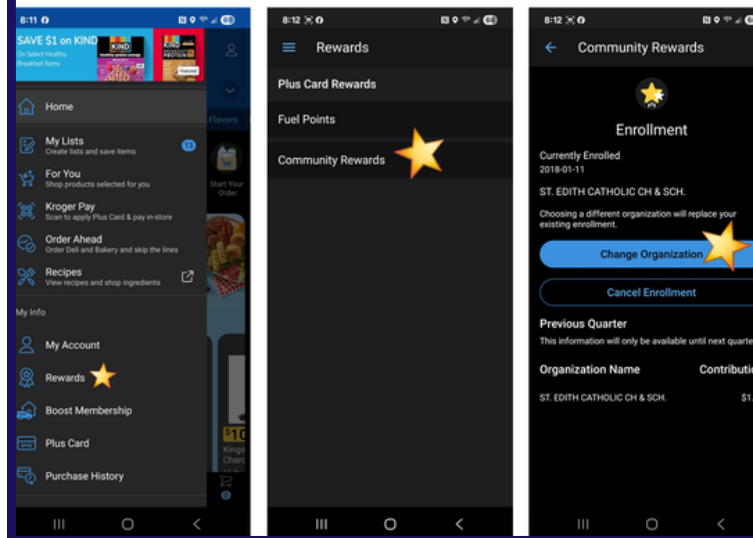
